THE PROGRAM

EM 385-1-1 (24hrs) Fall Protection

This three-day training program includes approximately 16 hours of classroom training and 8 hours of hands-on sessions. This course meets the training requirements for Competent Persons as dictated in the U.S. Army Corps EM-385-1-1 manual.

During the classroom portion, participants will be provided with in-depth instruction on all current and applicable fall protection regulations as *dictated in* the EM385-1-1 manual to include the ANSI/ASSE Z359 Fall Protection Code, and OSHA 29 CFR 1910, 1926 relevant standards.

To ensure that all participants have a clear understanding of the principles being presented, several written and practical exercises will be provided through-out the three-day training program.
