9 ACT Certifications

ACT is a universally recognized industry program that certifies the skills and expertise of installers in key areas. Developed through the combined efforts of leaders in the tile and stone industry. ACT certifications now in AIA MasterSpec and incorporated into the TCNA *Handbook* under the Installer and Contractor Qualified Labor section, encouraging architects and designers to directly reference this level of expertise when developing specifications.

There are a total of nine available ACT Certifications, with each consisting of a written test, and a hands-on evaluation.

Installers decide which certification or certifications they are seeking; installers do have the option to choose one, two or all of the available nine ACT certifications.

NOTE: ALL installers interested in ACT should attend an **ACT Orientation** and **TCNA Handbook & ANSI** class.

The orientation will consist of a power point presentation on ACT information, videos and pictures showing all of the 9 available certifications, the process, for both online written testing and hands-on evaluation. With an up-close look and review of ACT modules for the opportunity to ask all the critical questions.

The **TCNA Handbook & ANSI** class will provide an overview of the codes and standards that govern how ceramic tile installations are designed and installed. This class will also provide all relevant information to all 9 available ACT certifications, and all critical information that installers will need to guide them through the required online written testing.
